



KEYLOK Quick Start Guide – Evaluation Dongles Only

KEYLOK2, KEYLOK3, Fortress Windows Only

Note: Do not insert your USB key until after the software has been installed.

*To test and evaluate KEYLOK's hardware keys (KL2, KL3, Fortress), follow these simple steps.
This process usually takes less than an hour for basic protection.*

Step 1	Install the software and run the demo tool	5-10 Minutes
	<p>a) If you have not already, use the link provided to download the .iso disk image file. This is the evaluation SDK.</p> <p>b) In the top-level directory run Install.exe. This will install the Keylok libraries and drivers as needed.</p> <p>c) Run KLTool.exe to see and test the available core Keylok functions. (This does not include the Remote Update or Fortress-CodeVault functions. You can find information on these functions in the folder here.)</p>

Step 2	Compile and run the sample code for your development language	5-10 Minutes
	<p>Run the sample source code for your development language and environment. This will enable you to learn how to implement KEYLOK API calls.</p> <p>The appropriate sample code can be found in the folder here.</p>

Step 3	Protect your application	20-45 Minutes
	<p>Simply copy and paste the desired features from the sample code into your application.</p> <p>For a more detailed description of features and sample code See our KEYLOK User Manual.</p>
